DERBY CITY COUNCIL made these Traffic Regulation Orders on 6 August 2015, which come into effect on 10 August 2015, under Sections 1, 2, 4, 9, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers in that behalf:

Derby City Council (Devonshire Drive)

(Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No.72) Order 2015

The Order brings into effect on Devonshire Drive and East Avenue, Mickleover:

No Waiting At Any Time

- From Devonshire Court to No. 78 Devonshire Drive.
- From No. 85 Devonshire Drive to No. 11 East Avenue.
- From No. 92 to No. 103 Devonshire Drive.

No Waiting Monday to Friday, 8am – 6:30pm

- From No. 78 to No. 92 Devonshire Drive.
- From No. 85 to No. 101 Devonshire Drive.

Derby City Council (Castleward Area)

(Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No.33A) Order 2014

The Order brings into effect:

Canal Street between Carrington Street and Park Street

- Permit holders only

Carrington Street

- Permit holders only between Wellington Road and Trinity Street
- No Waiting at any time between Liversage Road and Trinity Street

Wellington Street

- Permit holders only on the western side

The following part of this order has been abandoned as the proposed highway works have not been undertaken:

Park Street between Wellington Road and Canal Street

- Permit holders only
- No Waiting at any time between the permit holder bays opposite the footpath to Midland Place

Derby City Council (Prohibition of Footway Parking, Derby City Centre)

(Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No.52) Order 2015

The Order brings into effect:

- **Area wide prohibition of waiting on footways and verges:**

In the city centre, bound by the A601 inner ring road.

Additionally, the Principal Order has been amended to prohibit waiting on footways and to take into account any future schemes which permit footway parking.

Derby City Council (Full Street)

(Amendment to Map Based Schedule) (No.36) Order 2014

The following part of this order has been abandoned as the proposed highway works have not been undertaken:

- Extend pay and display parking bay outside Silk Mill Public House by 2 car lengths.

Copies of the Orders, together with a map showing the definitive extents of the restriction and a copy of the Authority's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders, may be inspected during office hours at the reception of Derby City Council, Neighbourhoods, The Council House, Corporation Street, Derby, DE1 2FS.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Orders on the grounds that they are outside the powers of the Acts or because they do not comply with any requirement or regulations made under it, may, within six weeks of the date of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.
